It offers the visitor the most incredible natural experience to view the Arenal Volcano and tropical gardens.</p> <p>Your hospitality, comfort, and a real Costa Rica postcard memory will be your reward.</p> <p>Our rooms are equipped to make your journey something to remember, surrounded by the beautiful vegetation of the tropical forest.</p>	
AFTERNOON TOUR			
	<p>Arenal Volcano Tour (Silencio Trail)</p> <p>For those who are very interested in natural life of the rainforest, we begin the one and a half tour walk at 3:30 p.m. at the Silencio farm. Through the forest you have the possibility of spotting monkeys and a large variety of birds, including toucans. We end our walk with a refreshing beverage and a magnificent view to Arenal Volcano, where, with a bit of luck, you can see the lava of Costa Rica's most active volcano (erupting daily since 1968). We conclude the tour by relaxing in the nearby natural hot springs, from where you also can see lava rolling down.</p>	  	
6 th day	At Arenal / Today tour.		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ For today we have a The Honeycreeper canoe trip. The tour takes place in a class II River, combination of small rapids and flat water, guided by expert with full knowledge of the habitat and birds life. It is a great way to continue your new experience in Costa Rica. ✓ The tour start at 8:AM and finish at 1:30 PM. 		

Our canoes are quiet & non-intrusive. They carry us into otherwise inaccessible areas and allow us to approach many animals including monkeys, crocodiles, and three-toed sloth's, along with many species of tropical birds. The rivers lead us through the splendour of the rainforests rich with the life of ancient trees, delicate orchids, and brilliant bromeliads. Join us and leave behind the pressures and noise of civilization. You will be able to swim and relax on the riverbanks. See you on the rivers around Arenal!

7th day Today tour.

Day tour: To start the day, we have set up a Canopy tour " The Zip Line Adventure". You will get pick up at 8:AM, and will be in the canopy tour for around 2.5 hours.

It is a secure system of trails and zip lines, in the Monteverde Cloud Forest that offers visitors the opportunity to observe and appreciate the nature from different vantage points. To make it more fun we have incorporated some significant changes, such as metal platforms covered with mesh-covered and steel rails, which prevent falling or sliding.

The tour includes 4544 feet of trails, eleven transversal cables (from 131 feet to 2525 feet) long, and two observatory towers for a panoramic view (360°) of the Guanacaste, San Carlos and Puntarenas lowlands.



If you do not fill comfortable with the zip line, we also have **Sky Walk** is a spectacular combination of suspension bridges with easy and well maintained walking trails build in the Monteverde Cloud Forest and above the tropical forest canopy.



After the Canopy tour you can have breakfast back at the hotel, or at any local sodas (small restaurant) *this is our recommendation*, then you have the rest of the day to explore Monteverde on you own.

What ever you desice to do, you have to be out of Monteverde by 1:PM and on the way to Manuel Antonio Bech.

The Río Toro offers over 45-continuous rapids along more than 16 kilometers of deep-canyon gorges and waterfalls where we often see sloths, monkeys and tropical birds, such as toucans and the Montezuma Oropendula.
