|    | | <p>Welcome to Costa Rica.</p> <p>On your arrival day we will have our staff waiting for you outside the Airport. To schedule the pickup, we will need your flight information.</p> <p>Once we you pick up, we will take you to San Jose, the Capital of Costa Rica where you will stay for the 1st night.</p> <p>You will stay in this hotel 2 nights.</p> <p>Hotel location is only a few blocks from the most important cultural and historical landmarks in Downtown San Jose: the Costa Rica National Theatre, the Gold -, Jade - and National Museums, the (Costa Rican Congress), and the National Cathedral. | | Day 2 | Day Tour - White Water Rafting. |
|   | | <p>The Pacuare River is rated one of the top rivers in the world. You'll experience the intimate nature of the rainforest via the river. The warm water, cascading waterfalls, and opulently lush rainforest with its brilliantly colored plants, animals, and birds make this trip exquisite for your senses.</p> <p>Included: Professional bilingual guides, transportation from and to San Jose rafting equipment, breakfast, hot lunch at our Operations Center with comfortable open dining area and spacious changing rooms and showers.</p> <p>Difficulty: Moderate. Class III rafting: Rapids with high irregular waves; narrow passages that often require complex maneuvering. Class IV rafting: Long, difficult rapids with constricted passages that often require precise maneuvering in very turbulent waters. Rafting Distance: 14 miles River time: From 3-1/2 to 5 hours - depending on water level.</p> <p>Back in San Jose for 1 more night.</p> |

|     | | <p>Today we will make arrangements with the rent a Car Company to deliver your car at 8: AM at the Hotel.</p> <p>To get your rental you need: Driver License and Passport.</p> <p>Once you receive the Rental (SUV), you can start up your drive to Arenal. Instructions on how to get there will be provide by us on final paperwork.</p> <p>It should take you about 3.3 Hrs to get there. You can take your time and stop a couple of time to get the best of the trip. The check in is at 3:PM</p> <p>Once you get there you will stay one of the nicest places in Arenal. Lagos y Senderos Hotel. At this place the volcano is the first view you will have in the morning.</p> <p>If you happened to be there early, you can enjoy the facility of the hotel while you wait. They have a crocodile farm, butterfly farm, beautiful gardens and a thermal pool.</p> |
| | Day 4 | At Arenal – Day Tour Morning |
|    | | <p>After an early breakfast. You will be picking up at the lobby for your first experience at Arenal.</p> <p>We will set up a Canopy tour for the morning. This type of tour takes about 3 hrs and includes some walking or horseback riding. It is an adventure tour, and includes flying in the forest.</p> <p>“The Zip Line Adventure”. It is a secure system of zip lines, in the Arenal Rain Forest that offers visitors the opportunity to observe and appreciate the nature from different vantage points. To make it more fun we have incorporated some significant changes, such as metal platforms covered with mesh-covered and steel rails, which prevent falling or sliding.</p> |

At Arenal – Day Tour Late Afternoon

For the Afternoon, we will set up the Silencio Walking tour.

Arenal is well known for different activities, and today you will get pick up at the hotel for: Arenal Volcano Tour (Silencio Trail)

For those who are very interested in natural life of the rainforest, we begin the one and a half tour walk at 3:30 p.m. at the Silencio farm. Through the forest you have the possibility of spotting monkeys and a large variety of birds, including toucans. We end our walk with a refreshing beverage and a magnificent view to Arenal Volcano, where, with a bit of luck, you can see the lava of Costa Rica's most active volcano (erupting daily since 1968). We conclude the tour by relaxing in the nearby natural **hot springs**, from where you also can see lava.

- ✓ For today we have a [The Honeycreeper](#) canoe trip. The tour takes place in a class II River, combination of small rapids and flat water, guided by expert with full knowledge of the habitat and birds life. It is a great way to continue your new experience in Costa Rica.
- ✓ The tour start at 8: AM and finish at 1:30 PM.

Our canoes are quiet & non-intrusive. They carry us into otherwise inaccessible areas and allow us to approach many animals including monkeys, crocodiles, and three-toed sloth's, along with many species of tropical birds.
